

Abbreviated Summary of US SHIP

(AS PASSED AT THE US SHIP HOUSE DELEGATES, SEPTEMBER 2022)

Requirements for ASF-CSF Monitored Certification

Participating premises (farm sites and slaughter facilities) are enrolled with the US SHIP Official State Agency (US SHIP OSA) in state where premises is located.

Maintain valid veterinary client patient relationship

Premises level demographic information on-file with US SHIP OSA

Maintain records of all swine movement information in and out of participating premises

Demonstrate competence in providing at least 30 days of swine movement information in a common electronic format to the US SHIP OSA in timely manner

Boar studs only: Semen traceability, same as outlined for animal movement traceability

Compliance with existing state and federal animal/group/lot identification

In the event of an ASF or CSF incursion into the US, a temporary cessation of feeding spray-dried plasma, blood meal, meat and bone meal, intestinal peptide products, or other meal-based feedstuffs that have the potential to be of porcine origin will be implemented.

Feeding of swill, garbage, or table waste with potential for including meat products is prohibited

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(Continued) Requirements for ASF-CSF Monitored Certification

Five day down time and PPE requirements for visitors that have recently been exposed to livestock, wild pigs, or slaughter facilities in ASF/CSF/FMD positive areas/regions

Completion of biosecurity survey at enrollment

Boar Stud, Breeding Herd, Farrow to Feeder, Farrow to Finish, and Growing Pig sites must be able to provide access to a completed Secure Pork Supply Biosecurity Plan to the OSA within 24 hours of the request.

Maintain compliance of ASF-CSF sampling and testing requirements

- Requirements vary by production site type and the ASF-CSF status of the US, State, and Region
- In the absence of an introduction of ASF-CSF, no additional sampling and testing requirements
- US SHIP testing is for screening purposes to enhance early detection and demonstrating evidence of freedom of disease outside of control areas in a common and systematic fashion across all participating premises, supply chains, states, and regions.
